Use network providers and pharmacies

AARP® Medicare Advantage Walgreens from UHC GA-0001 (HMO-POS) has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies and other providers. For some services you can use providers that are not in our network. With this plan, you have the freedom to enjoy nationwide access to care at in-network costs when you visit any provider participating in the UnitedHealthcare® Medicare National Network (exclusions may apply). Plus, you have the flexibility to visit any provider nationwide who accepts Medicare. You may pay a higher copay or coinsurance when you see an out-of-network provider. If you use pharmacies that are not in our network, the plan may not pay for those drugs, or you may pay more than you pay at a network pharmacy.

You can go to **AARPMedicarePlans.com** to search for a network provider or pharmacy using the online directories. You can also view the plan Drug List (Formulary) to see what drugs are covered and if there are any restrictions.

Required Information
